Big Horn Education Fund (BHEF) scholarships are awarded to Big Horn seniors who will attend college or vocational school in the fall. In addition to completing this application form, you will be interviewed by a panel composed of the BHEF board members. Candidates will be evaluated on the basis of:

- **Academic Achievement**
- **Character and Civic Involvement**
- **Education and Career Goals**
- **Financial Need**

While the number of recipients is not fixed, we typically award 5-8 renewable scholarships in the amount of \$4,000. Funds for the scholarships come from the generous donations of community members and supporters of Big Horn School.
